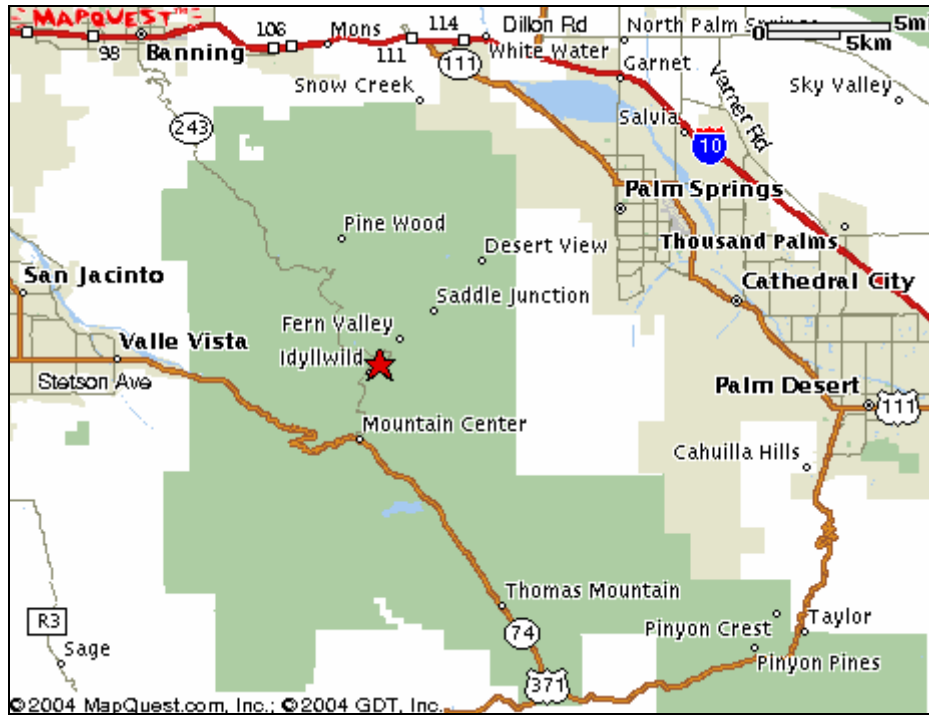


Kris' Camp I Can Camp

How do I get to Idyllwild?:

Directions: (taken from the Idyllwild Chamber of Commerce website)

From Los Angeles area: Take Freeway 60 or Interstate 10 to Banning. Exit Hwy 243 to Idyllwild. 100 miles.

From Orange County: Take Freeway 91 to Freeway 60 to Interstate 10 to Banning. Exit Hwy 243 to Idyllwild 93 miles.

From Palm Springs: From Interstate 10 to Banning, take Hwy 243 exit to Idyllwild. 47 miles.

From Palm Desert: From Highway 111 take Hwy 74 to Hwy 243 into Idyllwild. 47 miles.

From San Diego: From Interstate 15, take Hwy 79 So to Hwy 371 to Hwy 74 to Hwy 243 into Idyllwild. 114 miles.

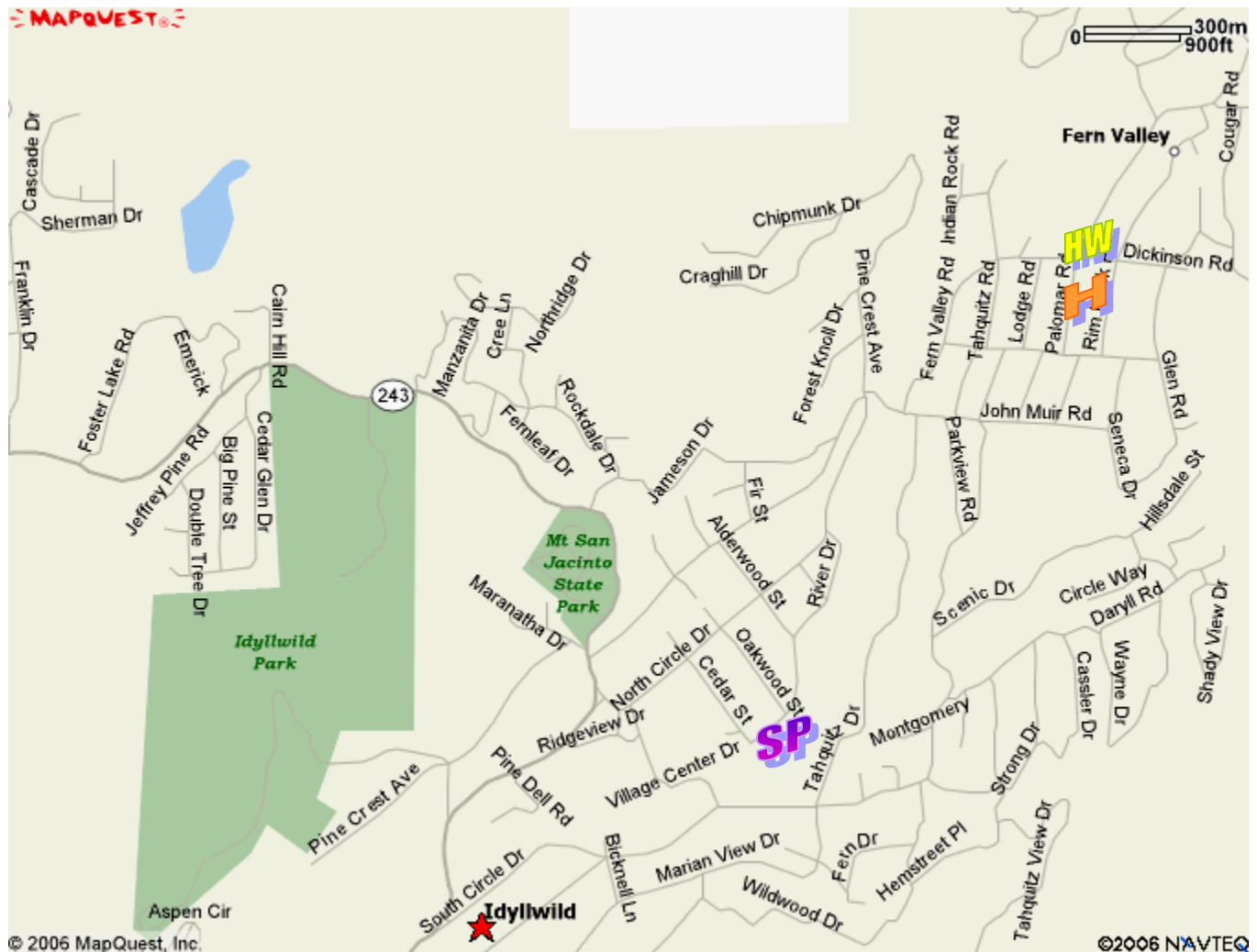
= Holder Cabin (see map below):

Address (Holder): 25420 Palomar, Idyllwild, CA 92549



= Hawthorne Cabin

Address: 55030 San Jacinto (it is actually right next to Holder, just on a different street)



Directions to Holder Cabin

1. Turn off Hwy. 243 UP North Circle which is the main street of town.
2. Continue up North Circle, (past Cedar St. which is where you would normally turn to go to Silver Pines Lodge) all the way up until you come to a stop sign which is South Circle.
3. Turn right on South Circle. Go about 300 yards and when South Circle curves very sharply to the right, DO NOT CURVE...GO STRAIGHT! Now you should be on John Muir.
4. Your first left once on John Muir is Palomar. Turn left.
5. Go almost to the end of Palomar street. Holder Cabin is the next to the last house on the right hand side. Address is 25420 Palomar.

Drop Off/Pick Up Schedule
